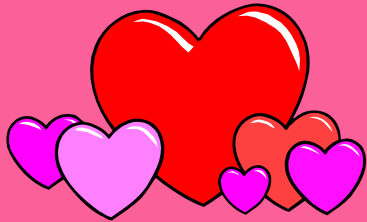

Dog Tags & Business Licenses Due!

Every dog in the Alma city limits must be registered whether an indoor or outdoor pet. Please register your dog at City Hall and provide proof of current rabies vaccination. There is a \$2.00 fee for each Dog Tag.

Business Licenses are due also for the 2011 year. There is a \$7.00 fee.

Reminder that these two fees are the only thing that the City of Alma will collect, as the County does not collect these for municipalities!

With the City of Alma wrapping up the audit this month, it now brings many opportunities for the City to take advantage of grants and other services available to municipalities to help pay for projects that we could not afford before! The Council already has their priority list made of what they would like to see get accomplished in the next couple of years, but what is on your list?? Alderman Justin Boehmer and I just submitted a grant application from Missouri Department of Natural Resources for recycled tire surfacing. If we are awarded the grant we plan on installing pour-n-place recycled tire surfacing under all the park playground equipment. This material would be much cleaner for the kids to play on and much safer. We also applied for recycled shredded tire mulch to use around the bandstand, gazebo, and around some trees that will be landscaped around this spring. This project was just one thing that the Park Commissioner wanted to see get done on his list. Please email me back or tell me next time you stop in the office, what the most important things you would like to see the City get done in the next couple of years!
